The Carolina Sports Journalism Camp is a four-day residential camp focused on classroom study and newsroom practice. The camp, for rising high school juniors and seniors, will feature visiting sports reporters and sports personalities. Students will take a behind-the-scenes tour of UNC's sports media facilities. They will cover a press conference and experience what it's like to work on a sports media deadline. Instructional sessions will include sports photography, sports broadcasting and sports writing.

Students will participate in an undergraduate sports writing course taught by lead instructor Tim Crothers. (Crothers is a former senior writer for *Sports Illustrated* and author of three books: *The Man Watching*, co-author with Roy Williams on William's autobiography, *Hard Work: A Life On and Off the Court*, and *The Queen Of Katwe*, which has been made into a Disney feature film. His work has also appeared in *New York Times Magazine* and *ESPN The Magazine*.)
